



Case Study Caribbean Princess

Overview

Princess Cruise Lines, part of Carnival Corporation, invested \$8.2 million in a full renovation programme on the Caribbean Princess.

Measuring 290m, the 113,000 tonne cruise ship entered the Grand Bahama Shipyard for a full makeover.

The ship's Explorers' Lounge underwent a complete stage refurbishment. Showcasing Broadway-style productions at sea, the Princess' theatre is amongst the largest of the ships entertainment venues with state of the art facilities to accommodate elaborate stage sets.
